Please tell me what you would like to most see improve about your Rally performance:

Teams can arrive 15 min early to set up and to potty your dog. Please remember to bring a crate for your dog, a chair, a water bowl, a chewy or snuffle matt to help your dog relax and stay quiet when needed in the crate. Please bring treats and some “high value” rewards as well such as hot dogs, chicken, roast beef or cheese. We ask that you be both respectful and responsible with your dog and the dogs in the workshop. Please clean-up after them, keep ample space from other dogs when entering & exiting the building and please limit barking as to not disturb the workshop. All dogs participating can be on a flat buckle collar, a martingale or back-clip harness. **No prong collars, e-collars or choke chains will be permitted at these workshops.** We ask that dogs be on a 4ft leash if you have one, but a 5 ft or 6ft leash are both acceptable. No flexi or retractable leashes. All dogs that are attending must be current on all vaccines. You do not have submit proof because this is on a good faith basis, we do ask for your honesty as to keep all the dogs safe. This workshop will take a few short breaks at various times but working teams will be working a lot !!
